

ORANGE GROVE FAQ

WELCOME TO OUR VILLAGE

16148 Robinson Road, Gulfport, MS 3953

Our village in Orange Grove is located in northwest Gulfport. It's set up on open church ground and is only a couple minutes' drive from local stores and restaurants. This village is heavily involved in the rebuilding process, with jobs including roofing, drywall, framing, flooring. There is a high demand for skilled labor, such as electricians, carpenters, contractors, and those with construction knowledge. For those without building skills, there is also work in the kitchen and opportunities for those with computer skills.

There are hotels available within 3 miles of the village. There are 3 RV camps in the area which may be contacted by internet at www.bayberryrvpark.com, www.southernrvparks.com/baywood, and www.campgroundsofthesouth.com.

There is a Lowe's and/or Home Depot 4 to 5 miles from the village.

We encourage you to venture out on your free time and enjoy the attractions of the area.

About the village:

- We do have TV in the village. There is also wireless internet service but no computers available for public use.
- We do not have electricity to the sleeping pods. Bring a battery lantern for the pod and a flashlight.
- You Do Not need to bring a N95 mask. You do not need to bring water but it would not be discouraged. It is a large expense.
- The pods are climate controlled, but we do have a few extra sleeping bags.
- We have thin mattress pads for the cots.
- We have a shower trailer with private hot water showers.
- We assign Pod numbers and the team leader assign's the group accordingly. There are 2-3 persons per small pod, 6-8 in larger pods.

Orientation is generally at 7:30 p.m. on Sunday.

Directions to the Village of Orange Grove

- Take I-10 to exit 34b
- Head north on Hwy 49 for 1.9 miles
- Take a left on Oak Lane 0.2 miles
- Turn right on Old Hwy. 49 for 0.4 miles.
- Turn left on Robinson Road for 0.2 miles
